If you are a parent who is nervous about your child getting behind the wheel, here are some steps you can take that will bring peace to your heart and help them become the responsible driver that will arrive safely.

Review the Driver's Manual so you have the correct knowledge. It is easy to forget correct driving procedures and develop other habits in our daily drive.

Set a good example; your student learns what they see.

Have a conversation about the privilege of driving. All new drivers are on probation for six months. Review Chapter 2; violations can result in suspension or revocation of a license. Parents have power to revoke their child's license until age 18.

We often assume our children will not engage in dangerous behaviors that put themselves and others at risk. Don't assume. Be clear about expectations and make them understand that crashes happen to those who never thought it would. Crashes happen in less than one second. Distractions are the leading cause. Giving in to distraction is a dangerous behavior.

If we are Responsible Drivers, we understand that operating our vehicle safely is the only thing that should occupy our mind during the moments we are moving up to 95 feet-per-second on our roadways. While we can help a driver develop necessary skills, ultimately a driver's attitude is the guardrail between them and the crash.
